Budget Committee Members Needed

The City of Tangent had two members of the Budget Committee resign last year. The City would again like to thank Alice Sperling and Ruth Shirley for their many years of service on the Budget Committee. The City would like to fill the two open positions by the first meeting which will be held in late April or early May. To qualify to be on the Budget Committee you must be a citizen of Tangent. The duties of the Budget Committee are to approve the budget that is presented by the Finance Director and Budget Officer of the City. Generally, this is accomplished in the first meeting, but, occasionally a second meeting needs to occur before the budget is adopted by the City Council at their June meeting.

To be considered by the City Council to become a Budget Committee member you must fill out a volunteer application which is available at City Hall located at 32166 Old Oak Drive. Marijuana News

Measure 91 allows for cities to ban recreational Marijuana, but this **cannot** be done by a City Council. It must be done by initiative petition by a citizen of Tangent. The vote would be required to be held in the next general election which would be November 2016. There is current discussion in the legislature to possibly change that requirement, but it is unknown if any legislation would be passed to change it at this time.

The Marijuana dispensary that was approved conditionally by the City Council will not be moving forward.

The Planning Commission will be discussing Marijuana Dispensaries, Recreational Uses, and Grow Sites to determine where these types of uses should be allowed in the next few months. The Transportation Safety Action Plan (TSAP) is Oregon's plan for reducing death and serious injury related to all transportation modes.

The TSAP is being updated and we want and need your input. There are a number of ways to participate in the update process, including attending a meeting or submitting your written suggestions.

The easiest way to be heard is to take the quick, relatively easy survey on the TSAP Update page found at http://www.oregon.gov/ODOT/TD/TP/Pages/tsap.aspx. We estimate most users will be able to complete the survey in about ten minutes.

The survey is at the top of the page in the Announcement section. On this site you can sign up to get automatic email updates to be advised when new information is added, check out the work of the Policy Advisory Committee, and more.
