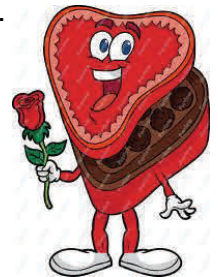

We appreciate the work they have done for our City; keeping the system going, and keeping our cost down as much as possible.

The City Manager, along with the City Engineer and City Council will be working on Request for Proposals (RFP) to contract with another service agency to serve as our Wastewater Operator. We are also searching for an interim firm, while the RFP process goes forward. Generally, this is accomplished in the first meeting, but, occasionally, a second meeting needs to occur before the budget is adopted by the City Council Meeting at their June meeting.
