REMINDER OF GRASS AND VEGETATION REGULATIONS

The City of Tangent would like to remind property owners that grass and vegetation on the property they own may not be more than 10 inches between May 1st and September 30th of each year. Failure to comply may result in the property being called a fire hazard and nuisance, which could mean a fine for every day the property has remained in a hazardous condition. Commercially cultivated agricultural crops are exempt from this requirement. The city's nuisance ordinance also states that properties must cut and remove from property they own or use, all dead bushes, dead trees, stumps, dry brush, dry vegetation, ladder fuels and any other material that could cause, spread or fuel fire. Tangent Business Goes Up In Flames

I want to express my appreciation to the Tangent community for your support at the recent fire on Birdfoot Drive. Several of you stopped by to offer water and refreshments, and the new owner of the Dixie Creek Saloon brought sandwiches to our fire-



fighters who were on fire watch throughout the night. I also want to thank our neighboring fire departments for their assistance. Albany, Lebanon, Corvallis, Halsey-Shedd, and Brownsville all sent apparatus and personnel. Our mutual aid agreements worked very well and operations went very smoothly. We made an initial interior attack, but due to the rapid fire growth, fuels and hazardous chemicals involved, and danger of collapse, we quickly changed to a defensive mode and



protected exposures. Without the sharp eye of Steve Hochstatter, aka Steve, the Sewer Guy, this fire could have been much worse. Thank you, Steve, for alerting anyone who was in the building and the Fire Department.

I would also like to remind everybody that starting June 15th and generally ending sometime in late September there is an outdoor burn ban due to high fire danger. Unlike the burn rules the rest of the year, which are imposed by the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for air quality purposes, the summer ban is from the Linn county Fire Defense chief and is related to the hot dry summer conditions. Outdoor burning during this time can result in a reckless burning citation from LCSO and if your fire causes any damage or injuries, you can be held financially and criminally responsible. This is shaping up to be a very busy summer in terms of fire danger, so we appreciate your help in keeping Tangent and Linn County safe.
