#### **Don't Forget . . .**

Tangent Fire District will be hosting a forum on crime and child abuse prevention. The forum, sponsored by the District and the Linn County Sheriff's Office on Thursday, June 23 from 6:30-8:30 PM at the Tangent Fire District classroom located at 32053 Birdfoot Drive. Speakers will include Jim Lepin, Crime Prevention Coordinator for the Linn County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Lepin will be covering crime data from the past six months for Linn County and the City of Tangent. He will review the steps to take on how to observe and report suspicious activities. He will also discuss methods to prevent thefts and burglaries. Marie Gennings, Director of The Family Tree will cover the prevention of child abuse through support for families of at-risk preschool children, and Tangent Fire Chief Scott Casebolt will discuss fire prevention and safety. There have been several recent incidents of criminal activity in the Tangent community, so we invite you to attend this forum.

#### **Reminder of Grass and Vegetation Regulations**

The City of Tangent would like to remind property owners that grass and vegetation on the property they own may not be more than 10 inches tall between May 1st and September 30th of each year. Failure to comply may result in the property being called a fire hazard and nuisance, which could mean a fine for every day the property has remained in a hazardous condition. Commercially cultivated agricultural crops are exempt from this requirement. The City's nuisance ordinance also states that properties must cut and remove from property they own or use, all dead bushes, dead trees, stumps, dry brush, dry vegetation, ladder fuel and any other material that could cause, spread, or fuel fire.
