## **Recycling News**

Even though these recycling items were covered in your Republic Services newsletter, this recycling news bears repeating; especially since some of it is the law. On January 1, 2015 the Electronics Recycling Law, known as the Oregon E-Cycles, was expanded from requiring the responsible recycling of computers, monitors, and TVs to include computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice and printers. Plastic bags cannot be recycled using the tan recycling carts because they will get caught in machinery at the recovery facility and potentially put workers at risk as they need to cut out all the plastic that has jammed the machinery. These plastic grocery bags and other plastic film (bread bags, plastic on paper towels and toilet paper, sandwich bags, etc.) can be placed in the bins found at the entrance of most grocery stores or taken to the Republic Services Recycling Depot in Corvallis on Belvue Avenue.

## **2015 Spring Clean Up Day**

This year's annual spring clean-up day will be May 16 from 9:00 am—2:00 pm and is sponsored by Republic Services (formerly Allied Waste). The location will be at Tangent Elementary School located at 32100 Old Oak Drive. Citizens of Tangent can take this opportunity to get rid of their excess trash; accepted materials include: yard debris, clean wood—not pressure treated, stained, or painted wood, scrap metal, large appliances. **This event is FREE and limited to residents of Tangent, so bring your ID with you to show the volunteers.**

**DO NOT BRING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS!!** IF you have hazardous materials such as household cleaners, paint, stain, aerosol cans, or light bulbs to dispose of, Republic Services will be accepting those hazmat items at their Corvallis location during hazmat events. To find out when the next hazmat event will be you can call Republic Services at 541-754-0444.
