Did You Know...

The City has partnered with Oregon State University Extension Service for the last several years to offer *free* nitrate testing for your well water. This year the partnership is offering the **4th Annual Nitrate Water Testing** for wells in the area on **May 12th from 3:30-6:30 pm**. All you need to do is bring about a cup of water, from your faucet, in a clean container to City Hall and you should have the results within 10-15 minutes, depending on how large the turnout is.

Did You Know... (part 2)

The City has partnered with Republic Services (Allied Waste) for many years to offer the citizens of Tangent the opportunity to get rid of their excess trash, scrap metal, wood waste, yard waste, appliances, and electronics they would normally need to take to the landfill for **FREE!!** On **May 17th between the hours of 8 am to 2 pm** the partnership is again offering this free service, collection site will be at J & H Trucking located at 33736 Hwy 99E (across from Wilco). **This is a FREE and limited event for residents of Tangent, so bring your ID with you to show the volunteers. Thanks!**
