Generally, this is accomplished in the first meeting, but, occasionally a second meeting needs to occur before the budget is adopted by the City Council at their June meeting.

To be considered by the City Council to become a Budget Committee member you must fill out a volunteer application which is available at City Hall located at 32166 Old Oak Drive.
