### **Save the Date**

Next month Tangent Fire District will be hosting a forum on crime and child abuse prevention. The forum, sponsored by Tangent Fire District and the Linn County Sheriff's Office, will be held on Thursday, June 23 from 6:30-8:30 PM at the Tangent Fire District classroom located at 32053 Birdfoot Drive. Speakers will include Jim Lepin, Crime Prevention Coordinator for the Linn County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Lepin will be covering crime data from the past six months for Linn County and the City of Tangent. He will review the steps to take on how to observe and report suspicious activities. He will also discuss methods to prevent thefts and burglaries. Marie Gennings, Director of The Family Tree will cover the prevention of child abuse through support for families of at-risk preschool children, and Tangent Fire Chief Scott Casebolt will discuss fire prevention and safety. There have been several recent incidents of criminal activity in the Tangent community, so we invite you to attend this forum.
