Medication Drop Boxes Available in Linn County

Disposing of unused medications at a drop-box keeps them out of the hands of teens and drug abusers, while also keeping medical pollution out of your drinking water. When you have unused medications, utilize these free local drop-box locations in Albany, Lebanon, and Sweet Home.

Albany Police Department, 1117 SE Jackson Street: Prescription drug drop-off is available Monday-Friday from 7:30 am to 6:30 pm. A permanent drop-box is located in the Albany Police Department lobby and is available Monday-Friday from 7:30 am to 6:30 pm. Lebanon Justice Center, 40 N. 2nd Street: A permanent prescription drug drop-off is located in the main lobby and is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. For more information, contact the Lebanon Police Department; 541-451-1751.
