Marijuana Town Hall Meeting

The City Council invites all residents and affected businesses to attend a special Town Hall meeting which will be held Wednesday, 7:00 p.m. on October 28, 2015 at the Tangent Rural Fire Department. We will be discussing the pros and cons of various types of marijuana operations that may occur in Tangent, such as wholesaling, processing, growing, dispensaries, and retail operations for both medical and recreational marijuana.

To date, Tangent has approved one Medical Marijuana Dispensary and one Medical Marijuana Grow operation under conditional use permits, but has enacted a ban on early sales of recreational marijuana through medical marijuana dispensaries until the Oregon State Liquor Control Commission issues rules and regulations on recreational marijuana.

The City Council encourages everyone to attend the Town Hall.

We have a new park in town. This park is located off of Tangent Drive on Meadow Wood Street in the new subdivision. It has play equipment, a bench, picnic table and barbeque. Many thanks go to Kerri and Trisun Spencer for their help in the design and coordination of various issues with this project. Come check it out!
